### **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. Power Distribution Construction and Maintenance
2. Learns how to construct and maintain overhead and underground distribution lines by:
  - terminating high and low voltage cables
  - connecting new services and installing new meters
  - repairing underground faults
  - trimming trees and clearing lines where necessary
3. Assists in the installation of poles and associated hardware for the construction of powerlines
4. Assists in the installation and maintenance of electrical equipment such as padmount transformers, switch gear, etc.
5. Maintain vehicles and equipment in good working order
6. Reports unsafe practices to supervisor
